



Grand Canyon University has partnered with the State of Arizona's Department of Child Safety to create a college pathway program that covers 100% of the costs for tuition, fees and room and board to help qualified Arizona students experiencing foster care achieve their academic goals.

What's included in the Scholarship?

- Tuition and Fees for Fall/Spring Semesters
- Room and board year-round (Fall/Spring/Summer Semesters)
- Specialized Admissions and Student Services Counselors
- Programming (optional) that incorporates mentorship, student worker opportunities, life skills and more!
- Tutoring

Requirements:

- Must be an Arizona resident
- Must be in state care at 17 years old to qualify
- Enrolled in the Volunteer Foster Care Program Agreement at 18 years old
- Must have an open case with the Arizona Department of Child Safety or served through the Extended Foster Care or After Care Program (TILP)
- Must live on campus at GCU to qualify
