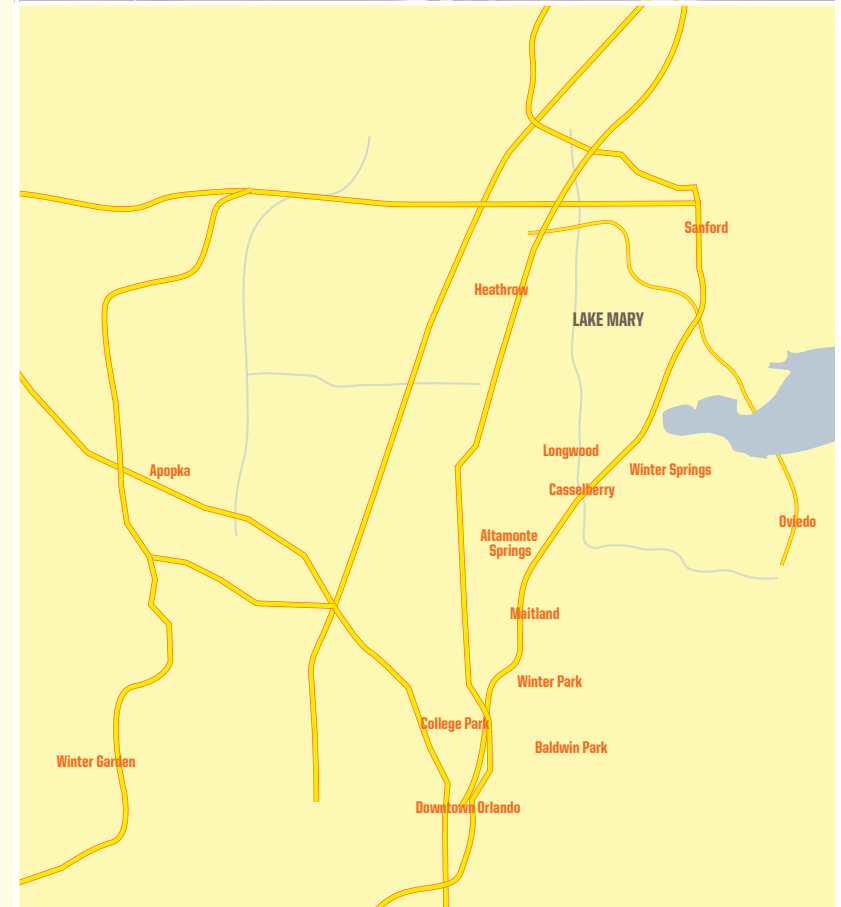
Neighborhoods

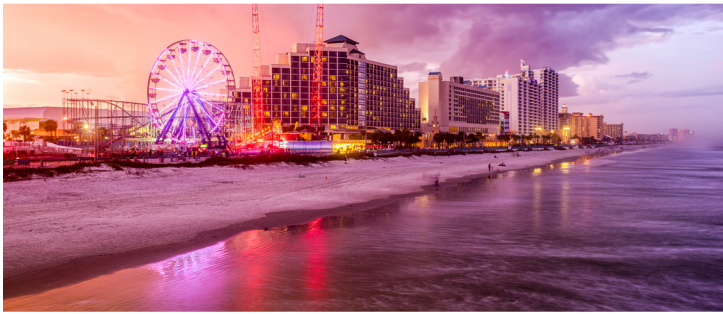

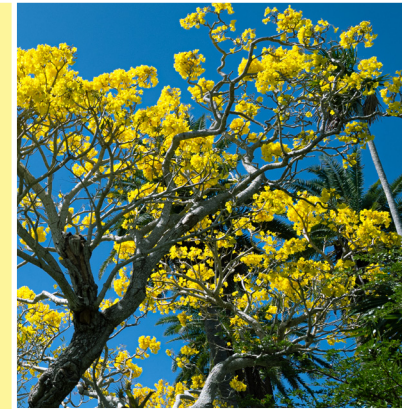

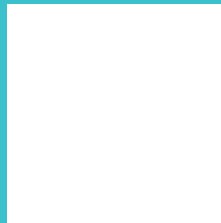
