LOPES UNOFFICIAL CREDIT EVALUATION

We review all previous college transcripts within 24 business hours to determine how these credits may apply to your desired GCU program. Once the unofficial evaluation is completed, GCU will contact you with an estimate of credits earned, an anticipated graduation date and a preliminary schedule.

INSTITUTIONAL LOPES

Through partnerships with community colleges, students in their associate program receive a plan that details their entire pathway to graduation at GCU. Students' plans are tailored to show how they can earn their bachelor's degree from start to finish.

ASSOCIATE TRANSFER PLAN

Students who complete a transfer-oriented associate degree (Associate of Arts or Associate of Science) at an accredited, GCU-approved college, university or program may fulfill the majority of GE required with the exception of University 101 and Christian Worldview
