INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION:

The Higher Learning Commission (HLC) accredits GCU as a postsecondary institution. This accreditation covers both GCU's traditional courses as well as online, providing a foundation of trust for quality education in both modalities.

Creating Community: Resources and Clubs

ON-CAMPUS FACILITIES AND STUDENT RESOURCES

Our campus is equipped with modern facilities and reliable theological resources to support your educational journey. From the library to our labs, we're here to help you reach your ministry goals. Here are some of the amenities available:

SPIRITUAL LIFE MINISTRIES:

GCU's Department of Spiritual Life offers many opportunities to serve and demonstrate your love of Christ. Ministries are student-led and occur weekly throughout the school year, reaching both local and global communities.

LOCAL OUTREACH TEAM

Sixteen ministries serve children in foster care and group homes, the homeless, the elderly and individuals transitioning out of prison. GCU partners with Habitat for Humanity and hosts two annual Lopes Go Local events to assist neighbors with home repairs and landscaping.

GLOBAL OUTREACH TEAM

Fourteen ministry programs offer transformative experiences for both students and those served. These programs serve refugee populations, promote student awareness and advocacy around global crises — and can help equip you to participate in short-term mission trips across the globe.

SPIRITUAL FORMATION

Weekly Spiritual Formation Workshops explore John Mark Comer's "Practicing the Way" course, offering practical tools to build a vibrant life with God and follow the way of Jesus — together.

CHAPEL AND THE GATHERING:

Held weekly during the school year, Chapel and The Gathering provide opportunities for students, faculty and staff to worship, hear God's Word and connect in community. Chapel is also streamed live on YouTube.

GRAND CANYON THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY:

GCTS helps prepare godly leaders for lifelong ministry rooted in biblical truth, sound theology and practical wisdom. Our master's degrees and graduate certificates aim to equip Christian leaders spiritually, theologically and professionally to serve faithfully in today's cultural context.

SEMINARY LIBRARY:

The new theological library offers extensive print and digital resources — including Bibles, commentaries, systematic theologies and historical texts. Thanks to partner contributions, the library is a hub for research, learning and spiritual growth.

JUMP START YOUR PASTORAL CAREER

BARNABAS PASTORAL PROGRAM:

This program provides formal education on the requirements and biblical teachings needed to serve in local ministries. It requires an additional commitment to uphold the moral values of GCU and the covenant that the College of Theology maintains. ACCELERATED UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE TO MASTER OF DIVINITY:

Students pursuing a Bachelor of Arts in Christian Ministry or Christian Studies (including all emphases) have the opportunity to take graduate-level courses while earning their undergraduate degree. This *fast-track option* allows you to jumpstart your graduate studies, allowing you to potentially complete both your bachelor's and a Master of Divinity in just five years.

THEOLOGY MINOR PROGRAMS:

GCU's College of Theology offers a range of minors that provide deep biblical, theological and spiritual education to prepare you for ministry and service. Our faculty helps you explore and refine your call to ministry, guiding you toward various paths, including the *Christian Ministry Minor (Pre-Seminary)*.



¹Travel reimbursement is only available to students who demonstrate their ability to meet admissibility for the traditional campus, plus one legal guardian, from a student's home city/state to Phoenix, AZ. School/district/organizations staff, faculty and/ or personnel are also eligible. To participate, the program requires a signed MOU by both the student and parent/guardian or personnel, approval of travel dates by GCU and receipts submitted per GCU requirements. Travel reimbursement thresholds vary based on location and education sector. Only one form of travel will be reimbursed, air or ground. GCU does not reimburse hotel expenses, baggage costs, early check-in or travel insurance fees. Travel reimbursement usually occurs within 45 days.

Grand Canyon University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLCommission.org), an institutional accreditation agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.
