GCU'S DUAL ENROLLMENT NURSING PATHWAY



Do you have students passionate about health care or still exploring their options? Grand Canyon University's dual enrollment nursing pathway provides them with an early introduction to nursing and health care courses — allowing them to earn college credits while in high school and start preparing for a future career.

These online, seven or 15-week courses are designed to allow your students the opportunity to complete all pre-nursing general education and prerequisite courses at a low tuition rate while in high school. This can potentially save them time and money while helping them build a strong academic foundation before starting college!

Qualified students who follow this pathway will be able to finish their last set of courses as a freshman in the fall semester, allowing them to enter either the Bachelor of Science in Nursing: Pre-Licensure program on campus or the accelerated BSN: Pre-Licensure program at one of our locations as freshman in the spring semester.

Dual Enrollment Pre-Nursing Pathway Courses:

- **Fully Online:** Students complete coursework asynchronously with GCU faculty guidance.
- **Hybrid Model (Arizona Only):** A blend of online learning and in-person instruction with your qualified teachers.
- **Fully In-School (Arizona Only):** All coursework is taught by your qualified teachers in a traditional classroom setting.
