# ***Transfer-Friendly Benefits***

## **➤ TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE**

## **➤ TRANSFER COURSE SEARCH TOOL**

Use our transfer credit tool to search for your courses from a prior school to see how your they might transfer.

## **➤ LOPES CREDIT EVALUATION**

We review all previous college transcripts within 24 hours to determine how these credits may be applied to a desired program at GCU. Once the evaluation is completed, GCU will contact you with an estimate of credits earned, an anticipated graduation date and a preliminary schedule.

## **➤ INSTITUTIONAL LOPES**

Through partnerships with community colleges, students in their associate program receive a plan that details their entire pathway to graduation at GCU. Students' plans are tailored to show how they can earn their bachelor's degree from start to finish.

## **➤ ASSOCIATE TRANSFER PLAN**

Students who complete a transfer-oriented associate degree (Associate of Arts or Associate of Science) at an accredited, GCU-approved college, university or program may fulfill GCU's general education requirements.

## **➤ GCU'S LETTER OF INTENT**
