

Competency Requirements:

Admission into the university

Automatic acceptance, no secondary application required:

- Cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of 3.8 or greater
- · OR ACT composite score of 31 or greater
- OR SAT score (combined verbal and math) of 1410 or greater
- Demonstrated passion for community service and leadership

TRANSFER STUDENTS

Competency Requirements:

- Admission into the university
- Earned a minimum of 24 college credits prior to seeking admission into the Honors College

Automatic acceptance, no secondary application required:

- Actively enrolled in a college honors program or Phi Theta Kappa chapter
- · Cumulative college GPA of 3.8 or greater
- Demonstrated passion for community service and leadership
