- Admissible into an eligible, nonlicensure GCU program of study
- Eligible for the Honors College
 - Automatically eligible: 3.8+
 cumulative high school unweighted
 GPA OR a 31 composite ACT
 OR a 1350 SAT
 - All other candidates are encouraged to apply
